2. INTRODUCTION

Heavy-duty garage and workshop trolley with 80/60kg capacity per shelf. Manufactured from extra-strong impact resistant plastic. Ideal for a variety of applications. One piece moulded shelves prevents spills transferring to lower levels. Fitted with four swivel castor wheels, two of which have brakes.

4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1. Unpack all parts.
- 4.2. Attach castors to bottom tray by pushing them into the corners of tray ensure tray is the correct way up. Use rubber mallet if required.
- 4.3. Apply brakes. Push four uprights into corners of bottom tray.
- 4.4. Align middle tray sockets with four uprights push into place. (CX205 Only)
- 4.5. Push four uprights into corners of middle tray. (CX205 Only)
- 4.6. Align top tray sockets with four uprights push into place.
