## 1. SAFETY

## 2. INTRODUCTION


**TOPCHEST:** Heavy-duty welded steel construction for strength and durability. Textured powder coat finish. Ball-bearing drawer slides provide superior performance and carry heavier loads, double sets on large drawers. All drawers have full width sand blasted aluminium 'Lift & Latch' drawer pulls, making easy-access while preventing inadvertent opening when box is being moved. Heavy-duty exterior handles. Non-slip drawer liners supplied for all drawers. Gas struts fitted to lid for easy-opening. Integral locking system locks all drawers with the turn of a key. Supplied with two keys. Use with Model No. PTB93006 Rollcab or can be a standalone unit.

**ROLLCAB:** Heavy-duty welded steel construction for strength and durability. Textured powder coat finish. Ball-bearing drawer slides provide superior performance and carry heavier loads, double sets on large drawers. All drawers have full width sand blasted aluminium 'Lift & Latch' drawer pulls, making easy-access while preventing inadvertent opening when box is being moved. Tubular chrome plated exterior side handle. Supplied with non-slip drawer liners fitted to each drawer. Heavy-duty Ø125mm Mag style castors, two swivel with toe brakes and two fixed. Integral locking system locks all drawers with the turn of a key. Supplied with two keys. Supplied with 12mm PVC coated MDF worktop for use as a workbench when not used with a topchest. Use with Model No. PTB91508 Topchest or can be a standalone unit.

## 4. ASSEMBLY

- ❑ **WARNING!** These units are heavy, obtain the help of at least one other person before attempting to unpack them.

### 4.1. INSTALL HANDLE (REFER TO FIG.1).

- 4.1.1. Position the holes and attach with the bolts provided. Tighten securely.

### 4.2. INSTALL WHEELS (ROLLCABS) (REFER TO FIG.2).




- 4.2.1. Carefully lay rollcab on its back, with a soft mat underneath for protection.
- 4.2.2. Install the two braked casters on the same end as the handle.
- 4.2.3. Insert the carriage bolts through washers, then through the casters and into the bottom of the cabinet. Tighten securely.
- 4.2.4. Install the fixed wheels on the opposite end to the handle.

### 4.3. REMOVE DRAWERS (REFER TO FIG.3).

- 4.3.1. Pull drawer out until it is almost fully extended.
- 4.3.2. Push up one black release lever, while pulling down the other hand black release lever.
- 4.3.3. Whilst holding the levers in these positions pull the drawer out until it is released from the drawer slide.

### 4.4. REPLACE DRAWERS (REFER TO FIG.3).

- 4.4.1. Extend the drawer slides from the tool chest/cabinet.
- 4.4.2. Insert the brackets on each side of the drawer into the slots in the chest/cabinet slides, being careful that they are properly positioned.
- 4.4.3. Once properly inserted, completely close the drawer to set the slides in their proper positions.





### 4.5. RAISE AND RELEASE DRAWER HANDLES (REFER TO FIG.4)

- 4.5.1. These units are equipped with raise and release drawer handles.
- 4.5.2. To open, lift up the drawer handle, whilst pulling it towards you. To close, shut the drawer firmly, until the latch engages.
- 4.5.3. If the drawer does not stay closed, the hook may be bent or it may rub against the drawer slides. To fix lightly bend the hook until the drawer will engage in the slide.

### 4.6. CHEST AND CABINET CONNECTION (REFER TO FIG.5) (OPTION PTB91508 OR PTB915TR)

- 4.6.1. Take out the work top from on top of the cabinet.
- 4.6.2. Place the chest on the cabinet.
- 4.6.3. Attach the connectors and make sure the hook head snaps into the square hole on the back of the chest. Fasten the screws to the cabinet.



## 5. MAINTENANCE

- 5.1. Lubricate the casters annually with bearing grease.
- 5.2. Lubricate the slides twice a year.
- 5.3. Periodically the drawer fronts, drawer trim and other surfaces should be cleaned with mild detergent and water.



### ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION
